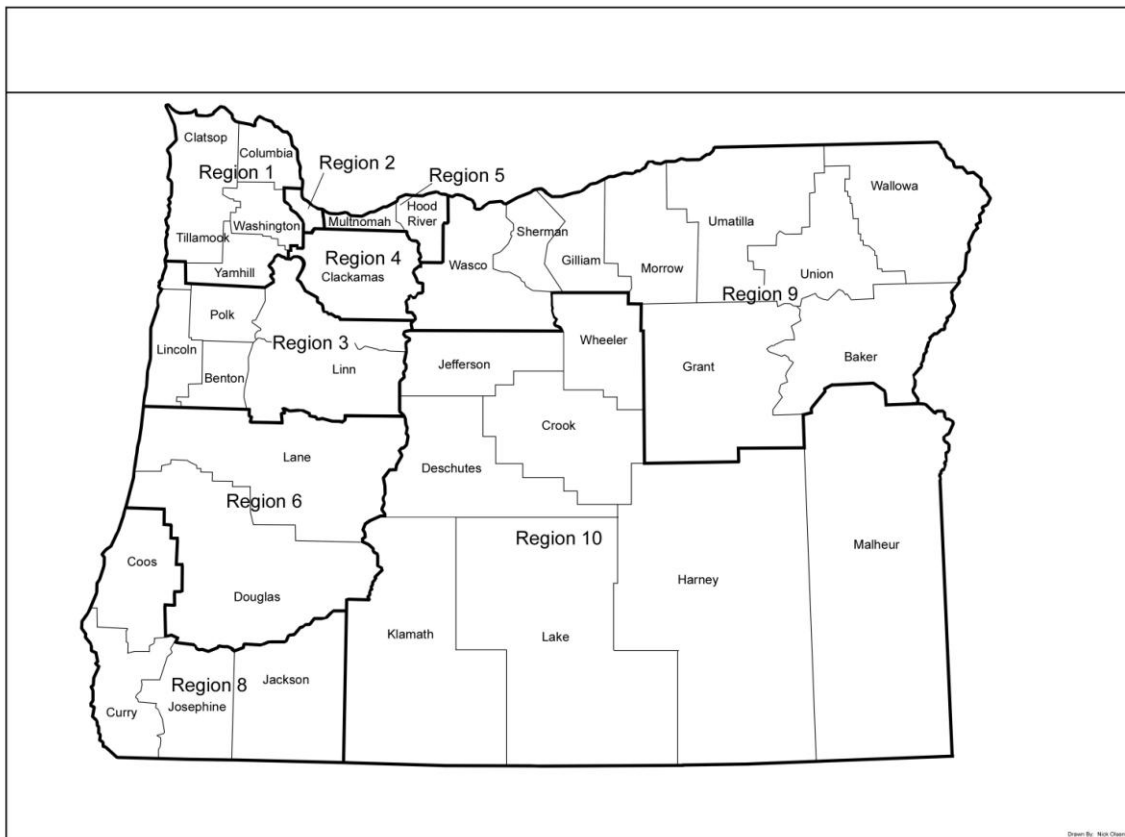

Oregon PTA Regions

A PTA Region is a geographic area within the state of Oregon. Oregon is currently comprised of 9 service regions. Each region is represented on the Oregon PTA Board of Directors by an elected Region Director. In addition to voicing the views of local unit members from their region at Board of Directors' meetings, it is the task of the Region Director to provide guidance, networking opportunities, and to help coordinate the activities of the local PTA/PTSA units within their particular region. Names and addresses for current Region Directors may be found in the listing for the Oregon PTA Board of Directors.



The Oregon PTA Office

- Maintains current mailing list of names of local PTA/PTSA unit presidents and officers, council presidents, state committee chairs, and the Oregon PTA Board of Directors.
- Maintains records of liability insurance (annual fee \$125, paid directly to AIM) for all local PTA/PTSA units, and the treasurer's bond for local unit bonding insurance.
- Maintains individual records of transactions with units, including membership.
- Distributes publications and materials to local PTA/PTSA unit presidents and chairs, including:
 - ◆ Officers' Manuals (Hard copies available for \$10 each)
 - ◆ Information regarding Oregon PTA meetings, conferences, and workshops
 - ◆ Convention information and registration
 - ◆ Additional Membership cards and treasurer's packets
 - ◆ Informational mailings
 - ◆ *onevoice* – electronically distributed newsletter
- Maintains a library of videotapes and other materials for use by local units.

Each issue provides a message from the state president, articles from state committee chairs, special sections on leadership, legislation, finance, health, programs, and membership. **onevoice** is a great resource tool. Units and councils are urged to forward it to the principal, school staff, and other interested individuals.

- ◆ **Our Children**
 - ▶ The National PTA Magazine brings in-depth articles on new developments and research in education, health, school financing, the family, and the handicapped, as well as National PTA projects and organizational news. It includes reports of PTA activities (local, state, and national) such as membership, leadership, current federal legislation relating to PTA priority concerns, National PTA Convention, and PTA policies and procedures.
 - ▶ Annual subscription (6 issues) of *Our Children* is only \$15 for members or \$25 for non-members. Where else can you get so much information for so little money?
