

Proposed Bylaw Amendment # 11 - Relationship with National PTA and Oregon PTA

Current Bylaw Revised June 2009:

Local Unit Bylaws
Article XIII, Section 2

SECTION 2. Oregon PTA requirements of a local PTA/PTSA unit:

a. Each local PTA/PTSA unit must have current copies of the following items on file at the Oregon PTA office annually.

1. Current officers list due by Nov. 1st
2. Standing rules due by Nov. 1st
3. Approved annual budget due by Nov. 1st
4. Membership lists and fees first list due by Nov. 1st there after monthly
5. Federal Employer Identification Number (EIN) (new units only)
6. Year-end financial statement due by Nov. 1st
7. Copy of Annual Audit Report due by November 1st
8. Copy of IRS 990 (if required to file) due by Nov. 30th
9. National PTA identification number (new units only)
10. Copy of CT-12 (if required to file) due by Nov. 30th
11. Local PTA/PTSA units are required to purchase general liability and bonding insurance through the Oregon PTA or provide proof of equivalent coverage annually by November 30th.

SECTION 2. Oregon PTA requirements of a local PTA/PTSA unit:

5. Federal Employer Identification Number (EIN) (new units only)
6. Year-end financial statement ~~due by Nov. 1st~~
7. Copy of Annual Audit Report ~~due by November 1st~~
8. Copy of IRS 990 (if required to file) ~~due by Nov. 30th~~
9. National PTA identification number (new units only)
10. Copy of CT-12 (if required to file) ~~due by Nov. 30th~~
11. Local PTA/PTSA units are required to purchase general liability and bonding insurance through the Oregon PTA or provide proof of equivalent coverage annually ~~by November 30th.~~

Rationale:

* This gives local units one (1) unified deadline for required documents to be filed with Oregon PTA.
