

Oregon PTA Leadership Conference & Convention Scholarship Application

A scholarship has been established to help local units send delegates to the annual Oregon PTA Leadership Conference & Convention. Twelve (12), \$100 scholarships are available for the 2010 event. This scholarship opportunity is for a **partially paid registration only**. Each scholarship recipient (local unit) is responsible for the balance of the registration fee (\$60 regular, \$90 late registration).

Rules for Eligibility

1. Only local units-in-good-standing may apply for the scholarship (*individuals* applying will be advised to submit application through their local unit.)

For the purposes of this scholarship, a local unit-in-good-standing is one that has submitted the following to Oregon PTA by February 15, 2010:

- Current year's officer's list
- Insurance premium
- Membership fees
- Budget
- Prior fiscal year's audit
- Prior year-end financial report

2. Only one (1) scholarship per unit will be awarded.
3. Local units receiving this scholarship agree to attend **all general sessions and workshops, and you are required to assist at the event and will be assigned a role and provided training.**
